Caterpillars Class

This week in Caterpillars class we have been very busy engaging in lots of different activities, here are some of the activities we have been doing....

Literacy – We looked at the book ‘Dear Fairy Godmother’ and we wrote our own letters to the Fairy Godmother. We have also been practising the names and sounds of letters.

Expressive Arts – We made boats out of junk modelling materials, then we tested them in water to see if they float or sink.

Mathematics – We worked on adding two numbers together to find the total.

Our Caterpillars role play area was set up as ‘Caterpillars Dentist’ we were very lucky and had a visit from our local dentist to talk about how to look after our teeth and how important they are.

Next Week...

In Caterpillars class next week we will, look at different flags from around the world and make our own. We will make a skeleton and look at our bones. Role play will be set up as a vets and hairdressers. We will make a dinosaur land, work on number recognition and we will be having a visit from a Spanish teacher who will read us a story in Spanish.

Ladybirds Class

This week Ladybirds class we have been busy trying lots of different activities.

KUW – This week we have been learning about looking after our teeth in our ‘Ladybirds Dentist’ roleplay area.

Expressive Art and Design – We used water colours to paint rainbows.

Literacy – We really enjoyed reading ‘The 3 little pigs’ and building the pigs houses from bricks, straws and sticks.

Mathematics – This week we have been looking at shapes, we have been learning the different names of shapes, circle, square and triangle by making pictures, playing games and puzzles.

We also practised our fine motor skills by making cups of tea.

Next Week...

We will make ice cream cones and sell them in our roleplay ice cream van. We will read and explore the book ‘Room on the Broom’ by making masks of the characters, playing whats in the bag and making potions. We will talk about our favourite book and dress up as our favourite characters and we will be flipping and throwing pancakes in to targets.

Extended Learning Ideas to do at Home...

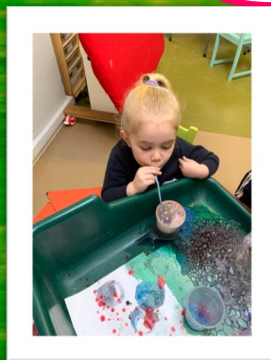
Talk about the different shapes that can be found around the home, for example rectangle windows, circle plates, square table etc.

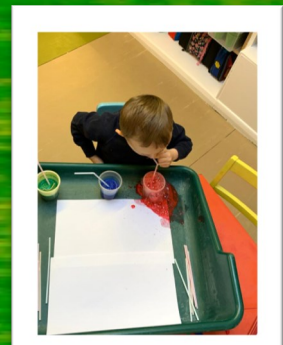

‘Caterpillars class made their own boats and then investigated which boats would float and sink’



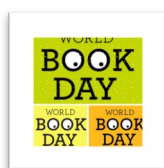
